



# FALLON RANGE TRAINING COMPLEX ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT

## PUBLIC SAFETY AND ACCESS

The Navy ensures personnel and the public are safe during military training activities.

### PUBLIC SAFETY MEASURES

The Navy takes precautions when planning and executing activities to ensure public safety by:

- ▶ Canceling or delaying activities if public safety is in question
- ▶ Ensuring impact areas and targets are unpopulated prior to potentially dangerous activities
- ▶ Notifying the public of certain activities
- ▶ Restricting access to training and testing areas when needed
- ▶ Working with communities to buffer key training ranges

### PUBLIC USE OF THE FALLON RANGE TRAINING COMPLEX

The Navy works to balance airspace and land-use needs with necessary training. Public and private activities which have been authorized in some portions of the range complex include:

- ▶ Hunting
- ▶ Fishing
- ▶ Livestock grazing
- ▶ Agriculture

### DRAFT EIS FINDINGS - Public Health and Safety

*Elements such as physical disturbance or soil and water impacts that directly affect the health and safety of the public in areas within and adjacent to the training complex*
