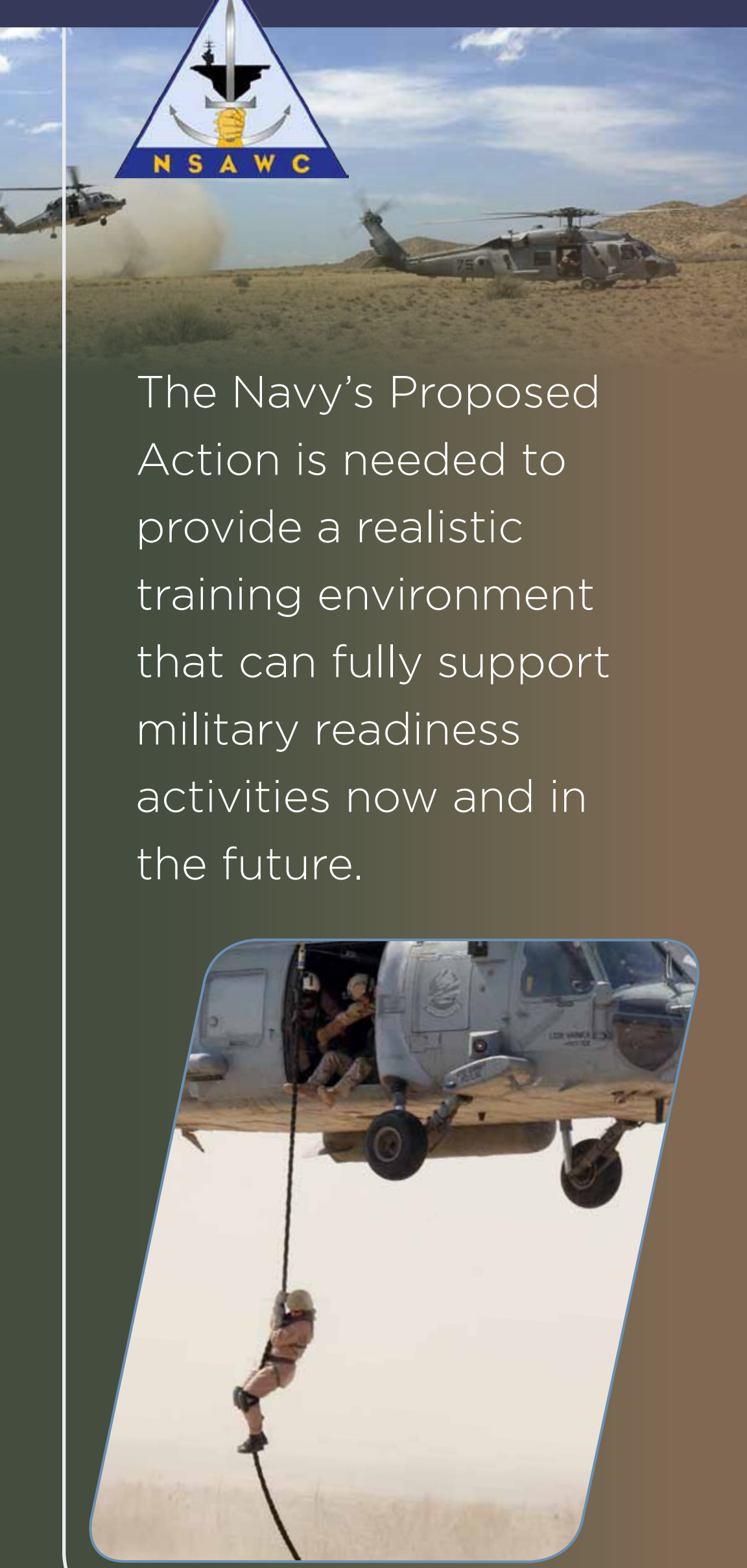




# FALLON RANGE TRAINING COMPLEX ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT

## PROPOSED ACTION AND ALTERNATIVES



The Navy's Proposed Action is needed to provide a realistic training environment that can fully support military readiness activities now and in the future.

### PROPOSED ACTION

To continue and enhance training activities within the Fallon Range Training Complex.

The Proposed Action would allow:

- ▶ Sustainable and modern ranges and facilities that fully support current and future training
- ▶ Continued accreditation and certification of Air Wing Fallon as a Joint National Training Capability program

### NO ACTION ALTERNATIVE

- ▶ Current level of training activities
- ▶ Is a baseline for assessing potential impacts of action alternatives

### ALTERNATIVE 1

The No Action Alternative plus:

- ▶ An increase in activities for specific mission areas
- ▶ Upgrades to range investments, including:
  - Tactical Combat Training System
  - Electronic Warfare Threat Systems
  - Fiber optic telecommunications

### ALTERNATIVE 2

Alternative 1 plus:

- ▶ An additional 10 percent annual increase in training activities
