## CULTURAL RESOURCES AND PROTECTIVE MEASURES

The Navy is a responsible environmental steward and protects sensitive cultural resources while training to accomplish its mission.

The Navy cooperates with federal, state and local agencies and tribes to protect sensitive cultural resources found in the Fallon Range Training Complex.

### CULTURAL RESOURCES IN THE FALLON RANGE TRAINING COMPLEX

- ▶ Approximately 500 known sites on training ranges
  - 20 eligible for National Register of Historic Places
- ▶ 94 known sites in Dixie Valley Training Area
  - 17 eligible for National Register of Historic Places
