PUBLIC SAFETY AND ACCESS

The Navy strives to ensure personnel and the public are safe during military readiness activities.

PUBLIC SAFETY MEASURES

The Navy observes precautions in planning and executing activities to ensure public safety by:

- ▶ Canceling or delaying activities if public safety is in question
- ▶ Ensuring impact areas and targets are unpopulated prior to potentially dangerous activities
- ▶ Giving notice of certain activities
- ▶ Restricting access to training and testing areas, as needed
- ▶ Working with communities to buffer key training ranges

PUBLIC USE OF THE FALLON RANGE TRAINING COMPLEX

The Navy works to balance airspace and land-use needs with necessary training. Public and private activities which have been authorized in some portions of the range complex include:

- ▶ Hunting
- ▶ Fishing
- ▶ Livestock grazing
